

Nain



A town in the SW of Galilee where Jesus raised a widow's only son from the dead. [Luke 7: 11-17](#). It was the first-recorded miracle of Jesus raising someone from the dead.

Nain, which means *pleasant pastures*, was about 9k (6 miles) SE of Nazareth, overlooked by Mount Tabor, and on the edge of the fertile Plain of Esdraelon and the Valley of Jezreel. Today there is a small arab village there, built on the ruins of a much larger town.
