Mount Nebo is a mountain in the Ibarim range in Moab, opposite Jericho, from which Moses was permitted to view the Promised Land, without entering it. <u>Deuteronomy 34: 1-4</u>

The rebellion of the people and Moses' failure to comply with the Lord's instructions are to be found in <u>Numbers 20: 2-13</u>

Moses was buried in a nearby valley. Deuteronomy 34: 5-8
