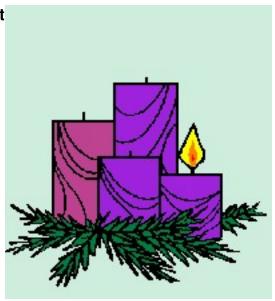
1st Sunday of Advent
